- -VFW Auxiliary National Organization; a national organization that provides support to veterans, military service personnel and their families, est. 1914.

- -William Penn (1644-1718) was an English writer, religious thinker, and a tireless advocate for liberty. He worked passionately for religious freedom in a world where freedom was subject to the whims of rulers.

- -Frederick Douglass was an American social reformer, abolitionist, orator, author, and statesman. He was a prominent voice in the fight against slavery and for human rights.

- -Ronald Wilson Reagan was an American actor and politician who served as the 40th President of the United States from 1981 to 1989. He became an important figure in the American conservative movement.

-Paul Tsongas was an American politician who represented Massachusetts in both the United States House of Representatives and in the United States Senate from 1979 until 1985. He ran for president in 1992.

- -Wendell Lewis Willkie was an American lawyer, corporate executive, and the 1940 Republican nominee for president.

-Baroness Margaret Hilda Roberts Thatcher studied chemistry at Somerville College, Oxford, and worked briefly as a research chemist before becoming a barrister. She became a British stateswoman who served as Prime Minister of the United Kingdom from 1979 to 1990.
