DUP Outreach Open House Idea

Even strangers can become friends in minutes while waiting in a checkout line. Bringing people together provides an opportunity for connection for which there is no substitute. After exhausting all efforts to reactivate and recruit in the Arizona White Mountains, a new tactic had to be discovered and tried. The key: an open house.

STEPS

- 1. Identify target area
- 2. Locate venue
- 3. Establish date (2 months out; respecting holidays & school district breaks)
- 4. Gather names and all contact information, mailing addresses & phone numbers: (Utilize ISDUP Membership Department for inactives, Members-at-Large. If without a mailing address, text a personal note with screenshot invitation attachment.
- 5. Design invitations (welcoming, informative, polished). Provide an extra invitation encouraging them to share with family or friends.
- Mail early (4-6 weeks out allows letters returned to be re-sent, recipients to respond, enthusiasts to advertise if they so choose, online, local newsletter, grocery stores, church)
- 7. Meeting itself (If possible, outdoor large sign to help direct to location)
 - a. Entry table to receive guests, supply markers, large adhesive name tags
 - b. Circulate clip board (to record full name, mailing address, phone#, degree of interest)
 - c. AGENDA
 - Welcome, introduce
 - Define objectives of meeting and DUP
 - Sing fun pioneer duet and sing along
 - Brief History of DUP in the area
 - "Stretching Exercise"
 - (Raise hands in answer to key questions concerning involvement & interest)
 - "Relatives Around Me" Activity w/cell phone app
 - MEMORY BOARD verbally/visually teaching DUP objectives, structure, goals, mechanics, highlights, goals of DUP
 - Q&A
- 8. Luncheon
- 9. Give-Away Table: membership applications, DUP coloring books, pioneer games, *Legacy* issues, DUP notepads, etc.
- 10. Farewell bags of honey-taffy tagged with "Thank you for Coming"
