- **Where is this Pioneer Home?**

Two homes were pictured in the Spring Issue of the *Legacy*. Did you guess where they are?

The first home is located in Centerville, Utah, and was built by B.H. Roberts, a pioneer Church Historian. It was built for his first wife, Sarah Louisa Smith Roberts, and later occupied by his second wife, Celia Ann Dibble Roberts. It is located at 315 South 300 East.

The second home is located in Farmington, Utah. It was built for Franklin D. Richards' tenth wife, Rhoda Harriet Foss Richards. She had married Willard Richards, but when he died a few years later, Brigham Young asked Franklin, Willard's nephew, to marry Rhoda so she would have someone to take care of her and her child. The home is located at 386 North 100 East.
