The Summer *Legacy* features a photo of a pioneer home that was built for Martha Williams Howell and her children in 1869. This home is located at 30 S 100 E Wellsville, UT, across the street from the Wellsville Tabernacle. Former Congressman Joseph Howell was one of Martha's sons, and he and his wife lived there periodically when he was not in Salt Lake. The current owners are Arlan and Lee Brandt.
