- **Marker #195 Bonneville Company, Ucon, Idaho**
Congratulations to the Members of the Bonneville Idaho Company for the re-dedication of Marker #195, Willow Creek Settlement. The marker is showcased on a newly built monument made of bricks including many from the original monument that was constructed in 1954. Located in Simmons Park, this monument also features a wooden cabin on the top.

- **990-N e-postcard**

For those companies and camps who still need to file their 990-N e-postcard for the 2024 fiscal year which ended on May 31, 2025, the deadline is October 15th. After that date, the IRS will consider your filing as delinquent. This applies to groups who have jurisdiction over a DUP cabin, satellite museum, or cemetery. If you need assistance, please contact the ISDUP treasurer.

Once you have set up the account, the actual filing instructions start in the middle of page 6 of the booklet.

It takes about 15 minutes or so for the status to change from "pending" to either "accepted" or "rejected." Log out of the website and then log back into the account after waiting at least 15 minutes and click on the "Manage Form 990-N Submission" option when the two boxes appear (it is the one on the right). It may take you to a page showing that the submission has been accepted or rejected. If it should take you a page where you are given the option to "click here to see updated status," click on that link and then the status will be changed to either "accepted" or "rejected." Let the ISDUP treasurer know when the filing has been accepted by the IRS.
